**Agreement on Student Exchange
Between
Japan University of Economics
And**



Borys Grinchenko Kyiv Metropolitan University

Based on the agreement between Japan University of Economics (hereinafter called JUE) and Borys Grinchenko Kyiv Metropolitan University (hereinafter called Grinchenko University), the two universities have further agreed to this agreement regarding an exchange program for undergraduate students.

1. JUE can send up to 2 students per academic year annually; 2 students studying for one semester will count as one student for academic year to be admitted to study at Grinchenko University based on the following conditions:
 - (1) JUE will submit to Grinchenko University applications for those students with the appropriate endorsement. Prior to the application, the coordinator of JUE will contact the counterpart at Grinchenko University to determine the courses to be taken, granting of credits, term of enrollment and advising (or supervising) university faculty members for the applicants. Final selection and approval will be made by Grinchenko University based on the exchange student admission processes.
 - (2) Exchange students have sufficient language ability (Ukrainian or English) to be able to follow the course of study.
 - (3) The term of enrollment shall commence at the beginning of either semester (first semester or second semester), and shall not continue more than one year or less than one semester.

2. Grinchenko University can send up to 2 students per academic year annually; 2 students studying for one semester will count as one student for academic year to be admitted to study at JUE based on the following conditions:
 - (1) Grinchenko University will submit to JUE applications for those students with the appropriate endorsement. Prior to the application, the coordinator of Grinchenko University will contact the counterpart at JUE to determine the courses to be taken, granting of credits, term of enrollment and advising (or supervising) university faculty members for the applicants. Final selection and approval will be made by JUE based on the exchange student admission processes.
 - (2) Exchange students have sufficient language ability (Japanese or English) to be able to follow the course of study.
 - (3) The term of enrollment shall commence at the beginning of either semester (first semester or second semester), and shall not continue more than one year or less than one semester.

3. The following conditions are applicable to exchange students of both JUE and Grinchenko University.
 - (1) Each university shall fully honor the credits and grades awarded by the other, and those credits and grades will be counted partially as requirements for graduation from each university based on its own system.
 - (2) Each exchange student shall pay regular tuition fees to his or her own university directly during the period of exchange. The "host" university shall charge no additional tuition including entrance and examination fees. However, exchange students from the "home" university will pay mandatory student fees (including insurance fee) as are charged by the host university.
 - (3) The host university shall accept no financial responsibility for exchange students' round trip travel expenses and their own costs for accommodations and meals, books, transportation and other personal expenses.
 - (4) JUE and Grinchenko University shall offer advice to the exchange students with respect to local arrangements, such as accommodation, board, and transportation.
 - (5) The host university shall provide a letter of acceptance to each incoming student and will assist him/her in obtaining appropriate visas.

4. It is intended that the number of exchange students participating from JUE and from Grinchenko University will be approximately the same.

5. Any difficulties or problems that arise in administering this agreement shall be settled by the Presidents, or the Deans, or the Coordinators of the respective universities in mutual consultation.

6. This agreement will take effect when it is signed by the presidents of both universities and it will be continued to be valid unless and until it is terminated by a written notice of any signatory party, or until 5 years has elapsed without successful implementation of the agreement.

7. This Agreement is concluded and signed in English in 2 copies, one for each Party. Both texts are equally valid.


